

SNOW & EXTREME WEATHER ROUTES

Winter weather conditions at times require bus transportation routes to be adjusted to allow safe travel. The Warrensburg R-VI School District and Apple Bus Company have established two levels of inclement weather routes for days when conditions allow schools to be open, but not all roads are passable for buses. Below is a description of each level of revised routes.

Snow Routes

Snow routes will be utilized when only small portions of the district are hazardous for buses to travel. Generally, a mild to moderate snow event can be handled safely by a bus except on routes with significant hills. If snow routes are to be run, notice will be provided through local media, text caster, Channel 99, and the district website. Please review the snow route schedule to determine if your route is affected.

Extreme Weather Routes

Extreme weather routes will be utilized only in situations similar to January 2007, when main roads were cleared but many rural roads remained snow and ice packed for several days. In such cases, school buses will run more limited routes for families who do feel it is safe for their children to travel to school on the bus. In general, extreme weather routes will be more limited than snow routes depending upon the nature and location of the route. Notice will be provided through local media, text caster, Channel 99, and the district website. Please review the extreme weather route schedule to determine if your route is affected.
